**General Meeting**  
**Minutes of May 20, 2015**

President Cathy House called the meeting to order at approximately 6:45 pm.

1. **Minutes of Previous Meeting** -The March 11, 2015 minutes were available for review. The minutes were unanimously approved.
2. **Treasurer's Report** -Dan Rosenthal distributed a written financial spreadsheet and summarized the financial picture. Family contributions to date have surpassed family contributions from fiscal year end 2013-2014. To date the ADCA family contributions were \$84,065 toward an \$82,000 budget goal. To date, the net proceeds from the Annual Auction and Party were \$43,031 the goal of which was \$55,000. Final numbers for the spring musical will be compiled in time for the next meeting in the fall 2015. Minus those numbers the total net income for 2014-2015 was \$142,605 toward a budgeted \$154,025 goal.
3. **Principal's Report** - Principal Albright provided a brief welcome to the large parent turn out, and mentioned the importance of the nights' topic of kids and internet safety.

5. **Guest Speaker.** Gregory Smith talked to the parent community about internet safety and children, specifically protecting your children on the internet. A power point slide and copies of the presentation were distributed. Mr. Smith talked about the real world risks children are exposed to on the internet and specific ways to mitigate that risk. Some recommendations included creating an internet use agreement; controlling admin passwords for all devices; limiting MMS functions on phones; prohibiting middle school children from youtube.com; installing content filters such as Cyber Patrol for Windows based systems or Net Nanny for IOS systems, and finally diligently monitoring our children's device and internet use consistently. Mr. Smith also provided a list of IM lingo, and the top six things parents can do to protect kids on the internet. Mr. Smith's book which was for sale is called, Protecting Your Children on the Internet.
